Requirement: Essay - approximately 750 words (to be judged on content, topic development, grammar and spelling)

TOPIC: Discuss the impact of shifting human populations within the watershed. Specifically, the European colonization of the late 18th Century. How did changing land management strategies affect individual species? Can parallels be drawn to the suburban sprawl of today?

The Bertsch-Hokendauqua-Catasauqua Watershed Association was founded in 2009

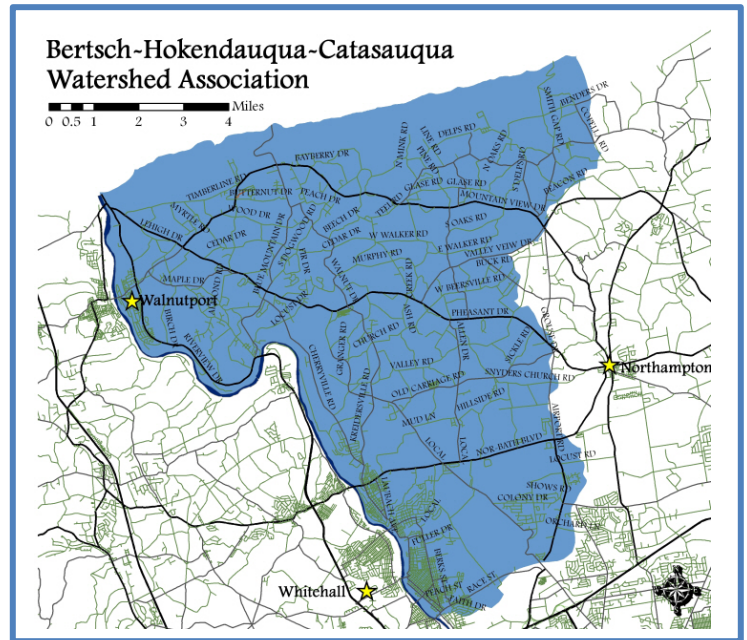
MISSION STATEMENT
